Who are Anam Cara?

Anam Cara work to empower women to improve their mental well-being, supporting them to become inspired, confident, strong, resilient women who are happy in their own skins.

Anam Cara work with women with low self-worth and low self-esteem. Women who may be using unhealthy coping mechanisms, including alcohol, drugs, food, or self-harming. Anam Cara ask that women who come to their sessions are ready to face their fears and are willing to commit to change.

Maria Martin founded Anam Cara and leads their work. Anam Cara are based in Midlothian, working across the Lothians and Scotland.

What did I do for them?

Anam Cara were previously known as Pink Ladies First, and had ten very successful years of providing services and support in Midlothian.

During the ten years, they built up a diverse funding base, established successful and productive relationships with local women and had a strong reputation with a range of professionals.

Following some changes in personnel, funding and motivation, Maria asked for some help. Unsure of what the next moves could be, for herself, the organisation and crucially for the women who relied on the support Pink Ladies First had provided, Maria wanted to evaluate all the options.

Third Quarter worked with Maria to look at different options for the future, which included difficult choices including potentially closing the doors.

Maria was then able to see clearly what was possible for the future, and took the decision, with the support of the Board, to rebrand, refocus and restructure, taking the best from the previous service and learning from the challenges of the past.
